Tree Care

Professionals:

The following businesses market themselves as tree care providers. Sustainable Claremont does not review their work or check credentials. We strongly encourage comparing quotes from multiple sources and checking references and credentials.

The best practice for tree care is to hire a consulting arborist to diagnose and recommend treatments for a tree, and a separate contractor to carry out any recommendations to avoid conflicts of interest. When hiring an arborist it is advised to:

- Ask for proof of insurance – personal, property damage, and workers' compensation.
- Examine any permits, licenses, and credentials.
- Ask for references, and check them.
- Ensure that they follow ANSI Standards; agree to not top trees, to not remove live wood without just cause, and to not prune City street trees.
- Get a written contract detailing items such as the project timeline, roles and total price.

If an arborist may be removing diseased wood, such as due to a polyphagous shot hole borer infestation, please ask how the wood will be disposed of. It is essential that infected wood not be transported without containment or sold for firewood. It must be chipped into small pieces, solarized, charred, or otherwise properly disposed of so we do not spread tree pests.

We recommend hiring contractors who have obtained the following certifications from professional organizations, such as the International Society of Arboriculture at www.isa-arbor.com:

- ISA Certified Arborist
- ISA Certified Tree Worker Climber Specialist
- ISA Tree Risk Assessment Qualification

State law requires that contractors doing more than \$500 worth of work must be licensed and bonded, and must pay workers compensation if they are not a sole proprietor. If you are a Claremont resident, you will also want to check to see if your contractor has a current business license with the City of Claremont.

Contractors:

The following business market themselves as sustainable solar electricity providers. Sustainable Claremont does not review their work or check credentials. It is up to you to check contractor credentials and references, and we strongly encourage comparing quotes from multiple sources.

Arborists

The best practice for tree care is to hire a consulting arborist to diagnose and recommend treatments for a tree, and a separate contractor to carry out any recommendations to avoid conflicts of interest. When hiring an arborist it is advised to:

- Ask for proof of insurance – personal, property damage, and workers' compensation.
- Examine any permits, licenses, and credentials.
- Ask for references, and check them.
- Check their membership in professional organizations (such as the International Society of Arboriculture at isa-arbor.com).
- Get more than one estimate, it may be well worth the extra time.
- Watch out for practices that may violate industry standards - topping trees, using climbing spikes on trees (OK during tree removal), and removing excessive live wood without just cause.
- Get a written contract detailing items such as when will the work be done, who will clean-up, and the total price.

If an arborist may be removing diseased wood, such as due to a polyphagous shot hole borer infestation, please ask how the wood will be disposed of. It is essential that infected wood not be transported without containment or sold for firewood. It must be chipped into small pieces, solarized, charred, or otherwise properly disposed of so we do not spread tree pests.

They must also follow ANSI Standards (www.standardsportal.org/usa_en/sdo/tcia.aspx), agree to not top trees, and to not prune City street trees. If you are a Claremont resident, you may also want to check to see if your contractor has a current business license with the City of Claremont.
